

THE EASTERN CICADA KILLER



- . Upon entering Rehoboth on the deck side, many of you have noticed the presence of the eastern cicada killer which looks like a Yellowjacket hornet. They are large and hairy with reddish and black areas as well as brownish with yellow stripes.
- . The eastern cicada killer is not aggressive unless grasped roughly, stepped on with bare feet or caught in clothing and usually fly away when swatted.
- . Please be aware that as long as they are unprovoked, they pose no danger.
- . Their season is projected to end at Mid-August.
