## **Thematic Focus Scripture: Matthew 18:18-20**

<sup>18</sup>"Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven."
<sup>19</sup>"Again I say unto you, That if two of you shall agree on earth as touching any thing that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of my Father which is in heaven."
<sup>20</sup>"For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them."

I. I want to suggest to all of us that everyone has a \_\_\_\_\_

An Agreement must be grounded in:

- Vertical connection with God
- Inner connection with Self
- Horizontal connection with Others

A Connection with others is rooted in:

- Self-concept
- Trust and Forgiveness
- Belief System/ Core Values
- Language of Actions/Activity
- II. All of us believe something.

- D. The \_\_\_\_\_\_ is one who believes that all events are ultimately determined by causes external to the will.
- E. The \_\_\_\_\_\_ is one who believes in the One and True Living God.

III. The idea is all of us are connected to a belief system.

The Connection between my belief system and others!

How can two walk together except they be agreed?

My belief system will do one of two things and sometimes it will do both:

IV. The Apostle Paul explained this to the church at Corinth. Most of us are familiar with **2 Corinthians 6:14** 

"Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness?"

## 2 Corinthians 6:1

"We then, *as* workers together *with him*, beseech *you* also that ye receive not the grace of God in vain."

One of the keys is that Paul describes the position as workers together...

#### 2 Corinthians 6:3

"Giving no offence in anything, that the ministry be not blamed:"

Paul argued that a process was needed.

#### 2 Corinthians 6:4

"But in all *things* approving ourselves as the ministers of God, in much patience, in afflictions, in necessities, in distresses,"

V. Approved vs. Non-Approved

Paul clearly outlined how you can test which category people fall into in your life.

## 2 Corinthians 4-10

4"But in all *things* approving ourselves as the ministers of God, in much patience, in afflictions, in necessities, in distresses," 5"In stripes, in imprisonments, in tumults, in labours, in watchings, in fastings;"

6"By pureness, by knowledge, by longsuffering, by kindness, by the Holy Ghost, by love unfeigned,"

7"By the word of truth, by the power of God, by the armour of righteousness on the right hand and on the left,"

8"By honour and dishonour, by evil report and good report: as deceivers, and *yet* true;"

9"As unknown, and *yet* well known; as dying, and, behold, we live; as chastened, and not killed;"

10"As sorrowful, yet alway rejoicing; as poor, yet making many rich; as having nothing, and *yet* possessing all things."

**Verses 4-10**, Paul listed all of the situations that he had encountered to demonstrate that he had been approved. And it was important to encamp yourself with others who had demonstrated the same proving process.

- 3. In necessities

- 5. In stripes
- 6. In imprisonments

- 7. In tumults
- 8. In labours

- 10.In fastings -

- VI. Paul wanted the Church at Corinth to know that his mouth and heart were open to them \_\_\_\_\_.

#### Verse 11

"O *ye* Corinthians, our mouth is open unto you, our heart is enlarged."

### Verse 12

"Ye are not straitened in us, but ye are straitened in your own bowels."

You are not straitened \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ in us but you are a straitened in your own bowels.

Why?

You are unequally yoked together with unbelievers

#### Verse 14

"Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness?"

The key to not being unequally yoked \_\_\_\_\_\_
