## **Define shame**:

- a painful feeling of humiliation or distress caused by the consciousness of wrong or foolish behavior.
- a feeling of embarrassment that arises from having done something dishonorable, immoral or improper.

The aim of shame is multi-dimensional:

- 1. To demean or to diminish
- 2. To extract self worth.
- 3. To make you and the act committed by you one in the same.
- 4. To create a veil around you so that that you cannot:

A. See clearly.

B. Prevent others from seeing you clearly.

This garment of shame projects to others:

- Unworthiness
- Mistreat me
- Handle me as you please.
- Please don't notice me.
