- I. The children of Israel came out as:
 - Recyclers of the old waste

- **II. Confusion** to wound or hurt; reproach
 - a state in which things are uncertain, foggy or jumbled
 - bewilderment
 - inability to act with clarity or understanding
 - a state of disorder or disturbance.
 - A. Confusion can be defined as 3 things:
 - 1. Confusion is a weapon of the enemy.
 In Latin, the root word of confusion means "to pour together."
 - 2. Confusion is a spirit.

 This spirit unleashes demonic activity through mental, emotional or physical struggles.
 - 'O Lord, let me never be put to confusion.'

Psalm 71:1

"In thee, O LORD, do I put my trust: let me never be put to confusion."

3. Confusion is a weight.
The weight of confusion is to bring about burden.
B. Why was confusion unacceptable?
1 Corinthians 14:33
"For God is not the author of confusion, but of peace, as
in all churches of the saints."
The Prophet's antidote for confusion was to rejoice.
