God made a covenant with Abraham...

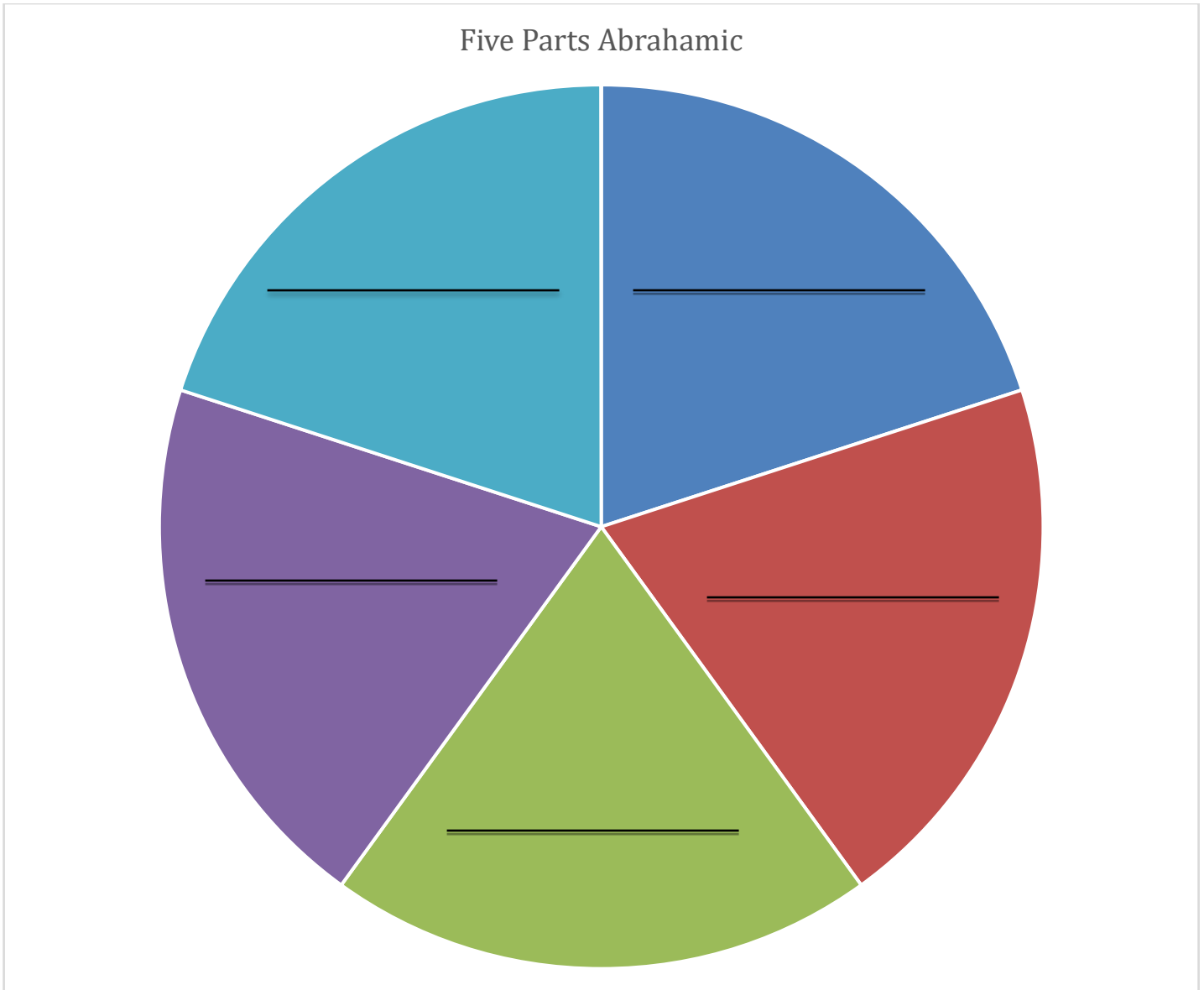
- I will make you a great nation.

Genesis 17:16 – *I will bless Sarah and give her a son.*

Genesis 17:17 – *Then Abraham fell on the ground and laughed...*
